**Optical Illusion Basket:** 4x8 racetrack slotted wooden base, twining, 2-2 twill with space dyed reed, 3 rod wale, continuous over-under, rimmed with waxed linen thread.

**Dimensions:** 4"x8" slotted base, 6" sides

**Skill Level:** All Levels

**Tools to bring:** old towel, tapestry needle, and sturdy scissors (if you have basic weaving tools, bring them, otherwise teacher will have some available to share)
